
1923 Season 2: Austinite Daniel Norton to Recur in Yellowstone Prequel [EXCLUSIVE]



Daniel Norton will play a recurring role in the upcoming Season 2 of Yellowstone prequel series *1923*, we have learned exclusively.

The official description of the new season of the series states:

In the second season of 1923, a cruel winter brings new challenges and unfinished business to Jacob (Ford) and Cara (Mirren) back at Dutton ranch. With harsh conditions and adversaries threatening to end the Dutton legacy, Spencer (Sklenar) embarks on an arduous journey home, racing against time to save his family in Montana. Meanwhile, Alexandra (Schlaepfer) sets off on her own harrowing trans-Atlantic journey to find Spencer and reclaim their love.

Norton is perhaps best known for many roles in films produced in Austin, including the SXSW selection *Tango Theory* and the acclaimed political dystopian drama, *Labor + Justice*. He also appeared in the Discovery Channel series *Detective Diaries*. Norton is also a seasoned stage actor, appearing in such plays as *Arsenic and Old Lace* (Mortimer), A Skull in Connemara (Mick), and the FronteraFest Best-of-Fest "Puppet Government" (MC).
